

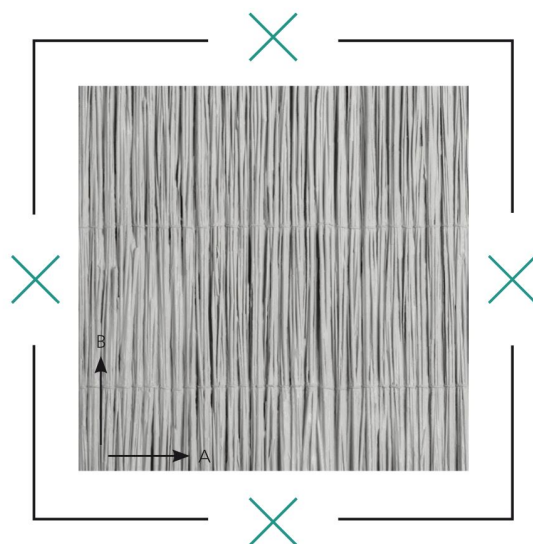
# Camargue

In the Camargue region of France, reeds were traditionally fastened together with wire or string to form mats and used to cover roofs, to insulate and even to build walls. The motif of this textured formliner captures and reproduces this old method of construction.
